

Vacancy: Scientific President

The Executive board of the European Rhinologic Society (ERS) is seeking to appoint a Scientific President for the ERS 2027 conference in Seville, Spain . The Scientific President will be responsible for developing and delivering the academic program for the Conference. The role will be supported by the Congress President, Dr. Ramon Morena Luna, the scientific programme committee and the members of the ERS Executive Board. The Scientific President will be the chair of the scientific programme committee and will be part of the Executive Board of ERS.

We are looking for:

- An ENT-surgeon with a sound academic background in Rhinology preferably with publications covering different scientific aspects (e.g. surgery and epidemiology; surgery)
- Experience in organising scientific meetings
- Experience in reviewing scientific works including excellent knowledge of formal guidelines for clinical trials & systematic reviews (like editorship, board of scientific journal)
- Managerial experience
- Excellent English language
- Willingness to work with the ERS secretariat in Amsterdam and the PCO (frei)

The term of office will be for one meeting (conference) but may be extendable to a second meeting by mutual agreement between the individual and the ERS executive or there will be an option to stay as the pas SP in order to help the new one to learn from your experience. The Scientific President of the ERS remains in post on the ERS Executive committee for the 2 year period following the meeting for which they are the SPC Chair giving the opportunity to play an important role in the running of the ERS.

Applicants should provide a **curriculum vitae** and a **personal statement** (maximum 500 words) outlining their vision for the academic program, along with evidence of previous academic and managerial experience before **14th of August**.
