Professor Carl Philpott trained in sinus and skull base surgery at the St Paul's Sinus Centre in Vancouver and is Professor of Rhinology & Olfactology at Norwich Medical School, UEA and Honorary Consultant Rhinologist at the James Paget and Norfolk & Norwich University Hospitals where he established the UK's first Smell & Taste Clinic. He has an academic practice with active research in chronic rhinosinusitis and olfactory disorders and is President of the British Otorhinolaryngology & Allied sciences Research Society. He is the Associate Editor for the Rhinology section of Clinical Otolaryngology and is on the editorial board of Rhinology Journal. He has an active role in patient advocacy as the Director of Research and Medical Affairs for the charity Fifth Sense.

Mr Martyn Barnes completed ENT training in Scotland in 2010 then two international fellowships covering the full spectrum of Advanced Sinonasal, Skull Base, and Facial Plastic surgery. He leads for Rhinology in Mid and South Essex, has hosted a fellowship programme, and works closely with Oral Surgery, OMFS, Ophthalmology, and Rheumatology. He has a strong academic background, with two masters degrees, multiple publications, and chapters for the Scott-Brown series textbooks. 
Visiting ENT Faculty:

Prof Amin Javer



Dr Javer is currently a full clinical professor in the department of surgery at the University of British Columbia, fellowship training director at UBC, co-director of research in the division of Otolaryngology at UBC, and director of the St. Paul's Sinus Centre. Dr Javer has varied research interests with over 120 research publications and over 15 book chapters. Post residency at UBC in 1998, Dr Javer proceeded to complete a two-year fellowship at the Georgia Nasal and Sinus Institute in Savannah, Georgia, specializing in Advanced Rhinology and Sinus/Skull Base Surgery under the directorship of Dr Frederick A Kuhn. Dr Javer has a special interest in advanced FESS (functional endoscopic sinus surgery), frontal sinus surgery, fungal sinus disease and recalcitrant chronic sinusitis. Dr Javer has been awarded several awards and honours in research and in surgical teaching during his career at UBC including the prestigious 'Richard Finlay Senor Scholar Award' in 2017. He started the sinus fellowship-training program at the St. Paul's Sinus Centre in 2001, which has graduated 27 subspecialized surgeons from eleven different countries. He presents internationally and is fluent in five languages.

Ms Louise Melia



Ms Louise Melia is a Consultant Rhinologist and Skull Base Surgeon in Bath and North Bristol. Following completion of her fellowship in advanced rhinology and open and endoscopic skull base surgery, she was appointed as a consultant at Glasgow Royal Infirmary in the West of Scotland, where she managed an extremely busy tertiary referral rhinology and skull base practice. She then moved to the South West of England bringing with her extensive experience in advanced approaches to the nose, sinuses, orbits, and skull base. She has authored a number of book chapters, including the upcoming Scott Brown 9th Edition. He peer reviews research papers for scientific journals and has lectured at major conferences in the UK and North America. He is the Director of the Guildford Sinus and Skullbase Surgery Course.

Peter Hwang, Zara Patel and Jayakar Nayak at Stanford University (Palo Alto, US), developing a subspecialty interest in rhinology and advanced endoscopic sinus surgery. He is a Fellow of the Royal College of Surgeons of England and was one of the first surgeons at UCL who was awarded a Fellowship from the Higher Education Academy in 2013. He has published more than 130 original articles covering smell, rhinology, cancer biology, tumour virology and experimental cancer medicine. He has been awarded the title 'Hunterian Professor' by the Royal College of Surgeons of England in 2020.
